Lakeview NeuroRehabilitation Center provides a functionally based, individualized treatment program for children, adolescents and young adults with neurologic and behavioral diagnoses. Lakeview uses a person centered approach and insures that family members are centrally involved through education and training. Funders are assisted through cost effective care and the achievement of functional outcomes.



RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

Lakeview's comprehensive program integrates all services through a treatment plan to address behavior management, education and therapeutic rehabilitation so the child can successfully develop and grow. Children and adolescents live in small log cabins with age appropriate peers. The leisure and recreational activities in which they participate enhance the rehabilitation process.

ON-SITE SCHOOL

Lakeview's on-site school integrates the Individualized Education Plan to meet the unique needs of each student. Lakeview is licensed by the State of New Hampshire and is approved for Special Education (grades 1-12) and as a Private Non-Public School (grades 1-12). Students attend school Monday-Friday, on a year round basis, including a comprehensive extended school year (ESY) program. Students will also have the opportunity to participate in winter and summer Special Olympics.



YOUNG ADULTS (AGES 18-21)

Lakeview meets the unique needs of the individual who is transitioning from adolescence to adulthood. Pre-vocational services become central to this individuals program as the young adult moves from a school based setting to healthy adult activity. The young adult lives with age appropriate peers and participates in the on-site school and vocational programs.

REFERRAL PROCESS

A referral can be made by an individual, family member, case manager or professional.

- Call the admissions department (800.473.4221), where intake information is obtained.
- Send pertinent medical and therapy records for clinical review.
- Schedule a tour of the facility and arrange to meet on site clinicians, Mon-Fri, 9am to 3pm. (Optional)
- Evaluation process, treatment plan, fee projections and recommendations will be developed and sent to appropriate parties.
- Secure funding for treatment.
- Tentative admission date will be established.
- Admission papers and health assessment is completed prior to admission.



ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Medically stable
- Youth: Ages 8-21
Adults: 18 years or older
- Neurological and Neurodevelopmental Diagnosis
- Cognitive level of 4 or more on the Rancho Los Amigos Scale
- Potential to improve functional status and benefit from services
